Charity fundraising is music to our ears

A charity concert led by Chopham Youth Orchestra will be held in Chopham Town Hall on the 20th December 2003. All monies raised will go towards supporting the work of the Primary Immunodeficiency Association.

The concert will begin at 7pm and will comprise of a seasonal mixture of Christmas carols, classical pieces and the odd Top Ten hit. The show will end with a raffle. Tickets are priced £5 and there will be a licensed bar.

People with primary immunodeficiencies are unable to fight off infection without the aid of antibiotics, lifelong infusion replacement therapy or bone marrow transplantation. Sometimes life-threatening and complex, they vary considerably in their nature and can be difficult to recognise and treat.

The Primary Immunodeficiency Association (PiA) is a national support group and registered charity for people with primary immunodeficiencies, their families and friends. It offers support to members through regional meetings, help with seeking appropriate medical consultation and assistance with securing state benefits.
